The university management recognizes the need for decentralization for the growth of the school and accords autonomy commensurate with the level of management. School Director and Head of Department are appointed who are given autonomy for efficient governance. The roles and responsibilities of administrators, coordinators / decision makers for various assigned jobs clearly depict the delegation of authority, providing operational autonomy leading to a decentralized governance system.

Director: To implement and monitor the education system to cater to the institute's vision and mission. He is responsible for the academic and administrative functions of the school.

Coordinators: Other support functions are handled by the Admission-in-charge, IQAC Coordinator, NAAC Coordinator, Examination Coordinator, Industry Institute Interaction Cell Coordinator, program Coordinators, NSS coordinator etc

At the school level: Each program has PG coordinator. Preparation of academic calendar based on time frame set by the University for planning and organizing of activities is done by Time Table co-ordinator. 


