The university administration recognizes the necessity for decentralization in order for the school to thrive and grants autonomy corresponding with management level. The School Director and Head of Department are appointed, and they are allowed autonomy in order to ensure effective governance. Administrators, coordinators, and decision makers' duties and responsibilities for various assigned jobs clearly portray the delegation of authority, enabling operational autonomy, and leading to a decentralized governance structure.

**Director:** In order to meet the institute's vision and objective, the education system must be implemented and monitored, director is in charge of the school's academic and administrative duties.

**Coordinators:** Other support functions are handled by the admission-in-charge, Academic- In

charge, Research Coordinators, IQAC Coordinator, NAAC Coordinator, Examination Coordinator, Industry Institute Interaction Cell Coordinator, program Coordinators etc.

**At the school level:** Each program has UG/PG coordinator. Preparation of academic calendar based on time frame set by the University for planning and organizing of activities is done by Time Table co-ordinator. Each program has a program co-ordinator who, in consultation with the faculty teaching the subject, get prepare the teaching plan for the semester, conducts meetings with faculty regularly to monitor and review course completion and attainment of course outcomes. Class guardian/mentor is designated for all classes.

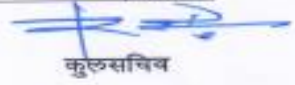
