## FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS ON INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

**Session I:** Introduction to IPR and its significance by Ms. Jahnvi Shetty, Senior IPR Associate, Patlex Business Solutions, Mumbai, Maharashtra.



This session covered the basic understanding of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in simple terms, highlighting the importance of protecting intangible assets like inventions, designs, brand names, and creative works. The speaker introduced various types of IPR, including patents, copyrights, trademarks, industrial designs, trade secrets, and geographical indications, explaining each with relatable examples. It was emphasized that just like one would protect tangible assets with security, intangible assets also require legal protection for commercial advantage and to prevent misuse.

The presentation explained how copyrights protect original creative works like literature and music, trademarks help in distinguishing brands, and industrial designs protect a product's visual appearance. Patents were described as legal rights for inventions, focusing on functionality and innovation, while trade secrets protect confidential business information. The session aimed to make participants aware of the value and need for securing intellectual creations through proper legal channels.

**Session II:** From Filing to Grant - The Patent Journey, by Ms. Sheetal Dube, Executive IPR, Patlex Business Solutions, Mumbai, Maharashtra.

This session covered the understanding of the patent process in simple language, guiding participants through the journey from filing to grant. It explained what a patent is, why it's important to file one, and how it differs from a research paper. The speaker highlighted the key criteria for patentability—novelty, inventive step, and industrial applicability—and gave an overview of the essential parts of a patent application, such as the abstract, claims, and detailed description.

The presentation also outlined the filing procedures, including provisional and complete applications, publication timelines, and the examination process. It explained the roles of FER (First Examination Report), response strategies, and possible hearings before grant. The session also touched on who is eligible for expedited examination and emphasized the importance of proper documentation and timely submissions to secure patent rights.

**Session III:** IPR POLICY by Mr. Vijaykumar Shivpuje, Director, Patlex Business Solutions, Latur, Maharashtra.



This session covered the importance of having a clear and structured Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) policy in academic institutions. It began with real-life inspired scenarios to highlight common conflicts around patent ownership, commercialization rights, and faculty contributions. The speaker stressed the need for institutes to address who holds the rights when inventions are developed with institutional support or beyond office hours. The goal was to trigger thought on legal and ethical responsibilities concerning IPR in academia.

It also emphasized best practices such as routing all these through the IPR cell, encouraging innovation through start-ups, organizing creativity workshops, and offering monetary incentives for patents and publications.
